

LESSON #6 EXPLAIN - STEPH

LESSON OVERVIEW:

Students will spend this lesson researching the connections and influences between Australia and countries in the Asian region. They will then use a Prezi presentation to demonstrate the links that they have discovered during this investigation, in an engaging for of technology.

LESSON GOALS:

Students will able to connect between Australia and Asia countries such as through trade, migration, tourism, aid, education, defence or cultural influences and explaining the effects of at least one of these connections on their own place and another place in Australia.
